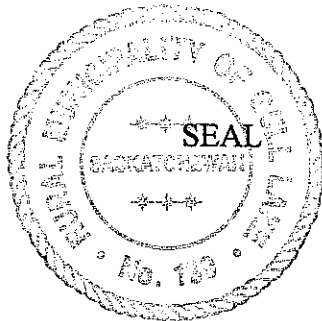
A BYLAW FOR THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GULL LAKE NO. 139 TO ESTABLISH SET BACK REQUIREMENTS FOR ORGANIC CROPS.


The Council for the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:


The purpose of this bylaw is to establish buffer zones for the protection of organic production units within the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139.

To prevent unintended contact with prohibited substances organic operators shall be required to:

1. Maintain a minimum 9 metre (30 foot) wide buffer zone separating the organic production from other private or public properties.
2. Permanent roads, road right of ways or undeveloped road allowances shall not be used as a buffer zone.
3. This bylaw comes into effect at time of being adopted, signed and sealed.
