

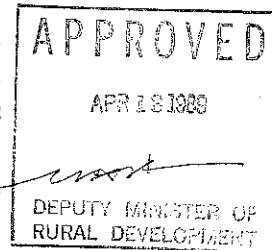
BYLAW NO. 1/88

A Bylaw to Repeal Previous Bylaws

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

All bylaws of this municipality prior to August 31, 1988 with the exception of bylaws number 70, 61, 104, 106, 70-2, 71-1, 71-2, 72-3, 75-2, 77-3, 78-1, 79-1, 80-1, 80-2, 82-1, 82-2, 83-1, 85-1, 85-2, 86-1 are hereby repealed, and the bylaws not repealed shall hereafter be known and referred to as bylaws number
