BYLAW NO. 11-90

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE ENFORCEMENT OF THE BYLAWS OF THE MUNICIPALITY PURSUANT TO SECTION 174 OF THE RURAL MUNLICIPALITY ACT, 1989

The council of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139, in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

- 1. This bylaw shall be known as and referred to as "The General Penalty Bylaw" of the municipality.
- 2. Sections 3 and 4 apply only to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
- 3. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any individual found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by the authority of $\frac{\text{The Rural Municipality Act, 1989}}{\text{Thousand Dollars ($2,000.00)}}$.
- 4. Subject to the provisions of section 2, any corporation found guilty of an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality, passed by the authority of The Rural Municipality Act, 1989 or any other Act, shall be liable to a penalty of not more than FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$5,000.00).
- 5. Bylaw No. 3/88 adopted October 4, 1988 is hereby repealed.
