

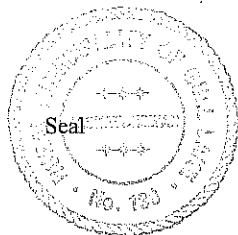

BYLAW NO. 110-10

BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF GULL LAKE NO. 139 ESTABLISHING  
REDUCED SPEED ZONES

The council of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts the following:

1. In this Bylaw the expression "road" means any public highway within the municipality as defined in the Highways and Transportation Act, other than a Provincial Highway as designated pursuant to such act.
2. "Maximum 60" kilometre per hour speed zones at farm sites on high volume roads authorized by resolution of council shall be erected as follows:  
Location of farm yards:
  - NE-31-13-19-W3M
  - NW-5-14-19-W3M
  - NE-31-14-19-W3M
  - SW-14-13-20-W3M
  - NW-7-15-19-W3M
  - SE-11-15-20-W3M
  - SW-2-13-21-W3M
  - SW-27-13-21-W3M
3. "Maximum 20" kilometre per hour speed zones on the road between farm sites NW 01-13-19 W3M and SW 01-13-19 W3M.
4. All signs pursuant to Section 2 hereof shall be placed directly adjacent to the beginning of the altered speed zone.
5. No person shall alter, damage, remove, deface, knock down or tamper with any sign erected pursuant to this bylaw.
6. Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
7. Bylaw No. 99-08 is hereby repealed.
