


BYLAW NO. 19-92

A BYLAW TO REGULATE THE USE OF MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY
LOCATED ON THE SE-02-15-20-W3M
PURSUANT TO SECTION 242(1(b)) OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT 1989

The council of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 in the
Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. No person shall:
 - (a) park a chemical spray apparatus; or
 - (b) park a truck or similar transport vehicle that contains full or used chemical containers, pumps, hoses or other equipment used in conjunction with a chemical sprayer within 100 metres of the said water supply.

3. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.


