


BYLAW NO. 20-92

A BYLAW TO REGULATE ACCESS TO THE MUNICIPAL WATER SUPPLY
LOCATED ON THE SE-02-15-20-W3M
PURSUANT TO SECTION 242(1(b)) OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY ACT 1989

The council of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Access to the said water supply shall remain locked at all times. Access may be obtained only by securing a key from the municipal administrator and paying the following fee:
\$100 - provides access to water for 12 consecutive months
\$ 25 - provides access to water for 3 consecutive months
2. A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this bylaw is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this municipality.




