

A BYLAW TO PROVIDE FOR THE PERMANENT CLOSURE OF A ROAD ALLOWANCE

WHEREAS Section 59 of the Highways and Transportation Act, allows a municipality to permanently close any road vested in the Crown with prior written consent of the Minister of Highways and Transportation AND after having given the public notice of the proposed closure;

AND WHEREAS the minister of Highways and Transportation has consented to AND Council has given the required public notice of the proposed closure;

THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts:

- (1) To permanently close the following public highway described as:

"All that portion of the original road allowance adjacent to the east boundary of the North-East Quarter of Section 15, Township 13, Range 19, West of the third Meridian, Saskatchewan, lying north of the right of way for the Canadian Pacific Railway, Plan S4156."

- (2) That the Administrator undertake such other things necessary to effect the intent of this Bylaw.
