

BYLAW NO. 51-98

A BYLAW RELATING TO THE REMOVAL OF TREES, SHRUBS, STONE PILES OR OTHER OBJECTS ADJACENT TO CERTAIN ROADS.

The council of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows under authority of section 206(2)(h),(o) & (6), of the R.M. Act. 1989:


1. For the purposes of this bylaw the expression:
 - a) "municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 of Saskatchewan;
 - b) "road" means any road allowance within the municipality other than:
 - (i) a private road, or
 - (ii) a provincial highway,
 - (iii) a road or highway within a hamlet
2. (a) Subject to Section 3 hereof, the Council may from time to time, by resolution, provide for the removal, at the expense of the municipality, of any brush, trees or shrubs growing on private property, or stone, earth or gravel piles, portable structures, machinery or other objects placed on private property within 60 metres (200 feet) from the centre line of any road or within 90 metres (300 feet) from the centre line of an intersection of a road allowance other than a provincial highway.

(b) Every resolution passed under subsection 2.(a) hereof shall designate the private property to which it relates.
3. Nothing in Section 2 hereof shall apply with respect to brush, trees or shrubs that:
 - a) were planted more than five years prior to the passing of this bylaw;
 - b) are used as a shelter belt, and
 - c) are situated more than 25 metres (80 feet) but less than 60 metres (200 feet) from the centre line of the road allowance at a location other than an intersection.
4. Any agent or servant of the municipality appointed by the council to carry out the provisions of Section 2 hereof shall have power for that purpose to enter upon the private property involved.
5. Any person who obstructs or interferes with an agent or servant of the municipality while engaged in carrying out the provisions of Section 2 hereof shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties prescribed by Section 175 of the Rural Municipality Act. 1989.


