A Bylaw for the establishment of an emergency Measures Organization

WHEREAS the Civil Defence Act. Cap 417. R.S.S. 1965, under Section

Nine (9), states that:
(1) The council of any municipality may establish a local civil defence and disaster organization and may appoint a director to organize, administer and operate such organization under the direction and control of the council.

(2) A council which establishes a local organization under sub-

section (1) may:
(a) levy, appropriate and expend funds, make contracts, obtain and distribute equipment, materials and supplies for the purpose of

(b) provide for the health and safety of persons and property including emergency assistance to victims of any disaster;

(c) employ with or without compensation, workers for civil

defence or disaster;

(d) assign employees, property or equipment of the municipality for civil defence, or in case of disaster, within or outside the

municipality;
AND WHEREAS a state of international tension continues to exist

which could be a threat to the survival of Canada;

AND WHEREAS the threat of a peacetime didaster in or near the

municipality will continue to exist;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable in the public interest that civil emergency plans be prepared in peacetime to meet emergencies created by peacetime disasters or emergencies of war;

AND WHEREAS it is desirable to ensure the continued functioning of the government of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 during

both peace and wartime emergencies;
AND WHEREAS the costs of establishing and maintaining an organization for civil emergency planning is shared by the Government of Canada and the Province of Saskatchewan:

THEREFORE THE Council of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No.

139 emacts as follows:

1. There is hereby established an Emergency Measures Control Committee which shall consist of at least three members of Council, who shall be appointed by resolution.

2. The Emergency Measures Control Committee shall be responsible for (a) Appointment of an Emergency Measures Organization Director

and such other employees as may be required.

(b) The review of all plans, programmes and expenditures relating to emergency planning.

(c) Submission to Council of estimates And of expenditures for the maintenance and operation of the Emergency Measures Organization.

(d) Submission to Council at least twice per year of a pregress report of activities.

(e) Submission to Council, for approval, of a municipal

emergency plan.

3. There shall be an Emergency Measures Planning Committee comprised of heads of municipal departments and emergency services or such other persons as may be deemed necessary for the Planning Comittee to formulate a municipal emergency plan.
4. The Chairman of the Planning Committee shall be the Emergency

Measures Organization Director.

5. Sach Department or emergency service of the municipality shall plan such measures and carry out such activities as are required to ensure a capability to meet their responsibilities in disaster.

5. The Council may, from time to time, borrow, levy, appropriate and expend monies required to meet the ordinary operating expenses of

the said organization.

7. The Emergency Measures Organization of the Rural Funicipality of Gull Lake No. 139 shall be comprised of the Reeve, the Emergency Leasures Control Committee and all departments and emergency services of the municipality.

8. The Council may co-operate with the Councils of other aunicipalities for the purpose of jointly establishing and operating

un Area Emergency Measures Organization.

WEEREAS the several municipalities above mentioned deem it expedient to enter into an agreement for the purpose of exercising the powers conferred upon them by Section (9) of the Civil Defence and Disaster Act, and outlining a general plan dealing with matters of civil defence and war emergency within the said municipalities; and

WHERRAS the parties to this agreement intend to establish an organization of the type contemplated in Section (9) of the said Civil Defence and Disaster Act;

NOW THEREFORE THIS INDENTURE WITNESSETH THAT:

- 1. The parties agree to joint action for civil emergency planning through formation of a Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Organization. It shall be known as the GULL LAKE MUTUAL AID AREA EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION.
- 2. The parties agree to the establishment of a Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Control Committee. This Committee should consist of two representatives from the Council of each member municipality. The representatives shall be appointed by Resolution of the respective Council.
- 3. The parties agree that the Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Organization Control Committee should appoint a Chairman and this appointment shall be confirmed by resolution of all Councils.
- 4. The parties agree that the Town of GULL LAKE be, and it is hereby designated as, the Administrative Headquarters of the Gull Lake Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Organization, A Mitual Aid Area Emergency Measures Co-Ordinator shall be appointed jointly by the parties hereto, to set up an Area E.M.O. Headquarters in the TOWN of GULL LAKE.

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- The parties agree that the aforesaid Mutual Aid Area Emergency Measures Organization Co-Ordinator, shall be charged with the responsibilty of working under the direction of THE GULL LAKE MUTUAL AID AREA EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION Control Committee, and any related sub-committees authorized by the Control Committee, with the objective of carrying out all reasonable preparatory steps designed to ensure, in the event of civil disaster or war emergency, that:-
 - (a) Essential departments of municipal government are able to make the most effective use of their personnel and resources.
 - (b) Plans for the survival and rehabilitation of the maximum numbers of the population be implemented without delay.
 - (c) The "Area " is prepared for reception of evacuees from other municipalities, provinces and states, and for the provision of mobile support to other Areas' as required.
- 6. Each municipality will develop its own Municipal Emergency Measures Organization and Municipal Directors will work under the direction of the Area Emergency Measures Organization Co-ordinator.
- 7. All authorized expenses incurred by the GULL LAKE MUTUAL AID AREA EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION shall be paid in the first instance by the Town of GULL LAKE, and the residual cost, after deducting all financial assistance relative thereto received by the Town of GULL LAKE from the Federal and Provincial Governments, to be shared between the parties in the proportions herein after specified.
- 8. Each party hereto shall calculate and contribute its share of the residual cost of this program on the basis of equal weight of ASSESSMENT and POPULATION.
- It is further agreed as follows:
