## **BYLAW NO. 124-13**

## A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH RESPECTING THE KEEPING OR HARBORING OF CERTAIN ANIMALS

Whereas the R.M. Gull Lake No. 139 has the authority to pass bylaws respecting the keeping or harboring of animals;

NOW THEREFORE THE R.M. GULL LAKE No 139, in Council assemble, enacts as follows;

Except as may be specifically permitted under The Wildlife Act or the regulations under the Act, no person, firm or corporation shall keep or harbor any of the following animas within the R.M. of Gull Lake No. 139:

- 1. All Venomous reptiles
- 2. The following species of snakes and lizards, and all their known races:

African Python, Indian Python, Blood or Short – tailed Python;
Reticulated Python, Timor Python, Diamond or Carpet Amethystine
Python, Olive Python, Brown Python, Sand ,Shovel nose , D 'Alberts or Boa Constrictor,
Madagascar Boa, Cuban Boa, Anaconda, Yellow Anaconda, Salvadoris Monitor ,Nile
Monitor Pacific, Rough–necked Monitor, Water or 2 Banded Monitor,
Giant Monitor, Bengal or Indian Monitor, Lace Monitor, Cape monitor;

- 3. All members of the order Crocodilia;
- 4. All non human Primates;
- 5. All members of order Carnivora excepting domestic dogs, domestic cats and ferrets;

Section 1 shall not apply to the following:

1. Any travelling show such as a circus or other like show.

This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect on the date of the final passing thereof.

This bylaw shall come into effect March 18, 2013.
