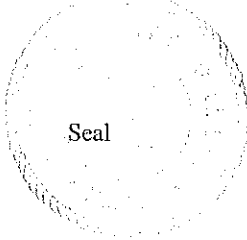




BYLAW NO. 115-10


**BYLAW PROHIBITING THE USE OF ENGINE RETARDERS IN DESIGNATED AREAS
OF THE MUNICIPALITY.**

The council of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts the following:


1. The use of engine retarder brakes are prohibited within the area of the NW quarter of section 12 Township 13 Range 19-W3M north to the Town of Gull Lake and the Green Terminal Road truck route north of NE-11-13-19-W3M.
2. Signs shall be erected in accordance with highway regulations before the farm site at south corner of NW-12-13-19-W3M and on the Green Terminal Road at the west corner of the NE-11-13-19-W3M
3. No person shall alter, damage, remove, deface, knock down or tamper with any sign erected pursuant to this bylaw.
4. Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
5. Bylaw No. 114-10 is hereby repealed.
