

BYLAW NO. 23-1994
ZONING BYLAW AMENDMENT
R.M. OF GULL LAKE NO. 139

Authority

Pursuant to Section 67, of The Planning and Development Act, 1983, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139, in the Province of Saskatchewan, hereby amends the original Zoning Bylaw No. 2/82 by enacting this bylaw as follows:

Text Change

To add the following subsection to Part 5 A A- Agricultural District, Section 3. Uses Permitted at Council's Discretion:

- "(xiv) Oil and gas related facilities such as battery sites, pipelines, and pumping facilities.
- (xv) Industrial landfills for processing of oil and gas field wastes and reclamation subject to any environmental standards council may establish in consultation with Sask. Environment and Resource Management."

Effective Date

This bylaw shall come into force on the date of approval by the Minister of Saskatchewan Municipal Government.
