

A BYLAW CONCERNING THE ERECTION OF HIGHWAY TRAFFIC SIGNS


The Council for the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In the Bylaw the expression "road" means any public highway within the municipality as defined in the Highways and Transportation Act, 1997, other than a Provincial Highway as designed pursuant to such act.
2. "Stop" signs shall be erected at the intersection of roadways at the following location:

South Side of SW 15-13-19 W3M where Range Road 3193 and Township Road 132 meet. Facing South from the East Side of Road and Facing North From the West Side of Road.
3. The signs shall be erected not less than two metres and not more than fifteen metres from the near edge of the intersected roadway.
4. No person shall alter, remove, deface, knock down or tamper with any sign erected pursuant to this Bylaw
5. The Provisions of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply, wherever applicable, to every sign erected.
6. Any person who violates any provision of this Bylaw shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties in the General Penalty Bylaw of the municipality.
