BYLAW NO. 58-99 A BYLAW TO CLOSE ROAD ALLOWANCE FOR GRAZING LEASE

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Gull Lake No. 139 in the Province of Saskatchewan under the authority of section 197 of *The Rural Municipality Act 1989* enacts as follows:

 Hereby closes the road east of NE-13-13-20-W3M for the purpose of entering into a lease with the adjacent land owner Cletus Grubb for grazing, further described as:

the road allowance which lies east of and adjacent to the NE 1/4 of Section 13, Township 13, Range 20 W3M.

- 2. The lessee shall provide access to the public at all times by placing gates at the north and south end of the road described in clause 1;
- 3. Persons who use any gates mentioned in clause 2 are to leave the gates closed when they have passed through the gates;
- 4. Any person who fails to leave a gate closed after he or she has passed through the gate is liable for any injury to any person or damage to any property occasioned by his or her failure;
- 5. This bylaw hereby repeals Bylaw No. 56-99.
